## PRIME7 STILL NO. I IN HISTORIC REGIONAL SWITCH YEAR RECORDS BIGGEST LEAD EVER

Consistent programs, consistent ratings, and consistently No.1 for PRIME7!

**PRIME7** is the regional leader again in 2016, remaining the most watched television Network across New South Wales (including the ACT and Gold Coast) and Victoria for the fourth year in a row.

With the official Television Survey Year concluding Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> November, results to date show that **PRIME7** is the No.1 Regional Network for 2016 with a free-to-air share of 31.4%. NINE Content Affiliates recorded 27.1%, the ABC is in third position with 18.0%, while the TEN Content Affiliates rank fourth with 16.9%. PRIME7 now has its largest lead ever over the opposition, with a record gap of 4.8 points to the nearest competitor.

Commenting on the winning end of year ratings results, PRIME Chief Executive Officer Ian Audsley said, "In a year which saw a once in a generation change where our competitors switched affiliation agreements, it's great to see that our consistent brand and programming continues to resonate strongly with viewers."
